Bird of the Month- Canada Geese

In the 1900's they were very limited in number. Now due to conservation efforts, there are over 5 million of them in the United States and Canada. They practice selective mating, seeking out partners who are similar in size. They also stick to one mate for life. The birds are usually two years old before they seek out a partner. The distinctive V-pattern Canada Geese fly in while migrating has a purpose. It helps the birds maintain their energy and improves communication. Each goose will fly above the bird in front of them to reduce wind resistance. And being able to see the other birds aids overall coordination. One goose has between 20-25,000 feathers.
